

**DAKOTA COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CDA)
RESIDENT REQUEST FOR SECTION 3 PREFERENCE**

Eligibility for Preference

A section 3 resident seeking preference in training and employment provided by this part shall certify, or submit evidence to the CDA, recipient contractor, or subcontractor, as requested, that the person is a Section 3 resident, as defined in Section 135.5. (An example of evidence of eligibility for the preference is evidence of receipt of public assistance, or evidence of participation in a public assistance program.)

SECTION 3 INCOME LIMITS

All residents of public housing developments of the Dakota County CDA qualify as Section 3 residents. Additionally, individuals residing in Dakota County or the surrounding metropolitan area who meet the income limits set forth below can also qualify for Section 3 status for applicable opportunities.

A picture identification card and proof of current residency is required.
