

Dakota County Preference Housing Choice Voucher Waiting List Closing - March 31, 2010

The Dakota County Community Development Agency (CDA) will be **closing** its waiting list for preference applicants to the Housing Choice Voucher Program at **4 p.m. on Wednesday, March 31, 2010.**

The Housing Choice Voucher Program (also known as Section 8) is a federal program that provides rental assistance for low- and moderate-income households. Program participants pay a minimum of 30% of their monthly adjusted income toward rent and the program provides the difference between the participants rent portion and the contract rent.

Preference applicants are those who live, work, are hired to work or go to school full-time in Dakota County. To qualify, school attendance must be at a vocational school with a diploma or certificate program or an institution offering a college degree.

Applications will not be accepted from non-preference applicants.

Preference applicants will be placed on the waiting list by the date and time their application is completed.

How to Apply

Applicants must appear in person before 4 p.m. on March 31, 2010 to complete an application at the CDA's office located at 1228 Town Centre Drive in Eagan, Minnesota. Driving directions are available by calling (651) 675-4440 and are also available online at www.dakotacda.org.

Applicants should bring a form of photo identification (such as a driver's license or immigration card) and proof of a Dakota County preference. Social Security numbers also must be provided for every household member that will be listed on the application.

Examples of preference documentation include: a driver's license, ID card or copy of a lease showing a Dakota County address, recent pay stubs for employment in Dakota County, or record of full-time enrollment at a Dakota County school.

Applicants not providing proof of a preference at the time of application will not be placed on the list. Only one application may be submitted per household. If more than one application for a household is received, all applications for that household will be discarded and will not be placed on the waiting list.

If you are currently on other CDA waiting lists, you must apply separately for the Housing Choice Voucher Program waiting list.
